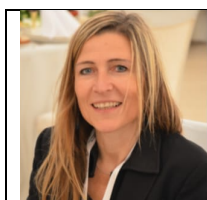

	Patricia Jonasson is an Associate Professor at Södertörn University. Her research focuses on Public Law and European Law, with a specialization in threats and violence against public officials as a threat to the rule of law.
	Jan Darpö is a Professor of Environmental Law. His research focuses on environmental procedures, water law, and nature conservation. He was a visiting professor at the University of Minnesota (2008) and at UNSW in Sydney (2012). Since 2008, he has served as Chair of the Task Force on Access to Justice under the Aarhus Convention. He is a member of the Avosetta Group and of the Advisory Board of EELFs. He has been appointed as an expert by the European Commission and by several research institutes.
	Said Mahmoudi holds a PhD in Legal Studies, has been a lecturer in international law since 1988, and has been a professor of international law at Stockholm University since 1999. He served as a diplomat at the Iranian Embassy in Stockholm and at the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of Iran. He is an arbitrator appointed by the Swedish government for the Law of the Sea.

	Mats Grahn is a professor of Evolutionary Biology at Södertörn University, teaching ecology, genetics, planning, and supervision in the environmental field to future environmental scientists. Associate Professor of Zoological Ecology, working as a lecturer since 1998 and, since 2014, as a professor at Södertörn University.
